We hoped to plant in 2011, but God opened a door for us to lead a church in Missouri. That opportunity paved the way for us to plant here in 2017.

We had our eye on a historic theatre for some time. It had just been bought out of foreclosure and was being renovated. After several meetings with the owner, he agreed to rent the space to us on Sundays. The theatre is located downtown and was a concert venue for years. Our mission: to be a place where people BELONG, come to BELIEVE in Christ, and BECOME who God designed them to be.
