About the Church Plant

The church planting team is made up of families and singles sent out from Emmanuel Baptist Church in Tuscaloosa, Ala. The first two units arrived in Portland in summer 2014.

Bridge City Church is located in North Portland, which is the most economically and ethnically diverse area of Portland. The four target neighborhoods for the plant are: St. Johns, Portsmouth, University Park and Cathedral Park. There are zero Southern Baptist churches in this area of need and opportunity. The four neighborhoods provide the density and diversity of an urban city, yet maintain a small-town feel.
