From successfully planting Eglise Manne du Salut-EMS, our first plant in Africa, to planting Rendezvous Scarborough in Toronto is a great risk—but it is a holy one. Can this success be duplicated? By the will of the One who owns heaven and earth.

Living on \$2 a day for a household of eight, my wife, Cesarie, our family and team planted 27 churches in Africa, among which 14 were built or rented in 14 years of ministry. This made Mungwa Community the lead church, what local people and visitors called "Mungwa the Island of Peace," in a country at war.

Toronto culture is different. However, no matter how people are blessed, Christ has got something money cannot buy: godly joy, godly peace, freedom and love.

We share this truth: a church in a community is like gold. More exciting though, is that the joy we got planting churches in communities has greatly strengthened our marriage and family, even when we lived apart during the waiting time for our Canadian visas. Is that not exciting?

### About the Church Plant

Rendezvous Scarborough aims to draw people to Christ and help them grow in the knowledge of God and Christ Jesus. Through our vision, "Together building a great city for all people of Toronto," Rendezvous Scarborough seeks to give a chance to all people to taste Christ. We recommend Christ's teaching as good for the individual and community and that a person can reject Christ at their own peril.

Our motto is "One God, One Gospel and One People." We describe Rendezvous Scarborough church as a strong multicultural church family that reflects God in Christ's love, character and power.
