About the Family

My name is Martin Haghani, and God has called me to serve as the pastor of a new church in Las Vegas called Iranian Baptist Church of Las Vegas. My wife and I both grew up in Iran. God did a radical work in our marriage. He brought us to Las Vegas, and we never looked back. We have dedicated our lives to serving the Lord.

I was born in Iran on July 18, 1948, into a Muslim and Jewish family. My father was Jewish and my mother Muslim. In Iran, Muslims comprise 99 percent of the population and Christians and Jews suffer great oppression.

In December 1964, at the age of 17, I emigrated from Iran to Israel the Holy Land. In November 1966, I started my voluntary service in the army of Israel for three years. I become an officer and fought for the Holy Land in two wars: the Six-Day War and the Yom Kippur War. I attended Tel Aviv University Institute of Business Management during my stay in the Holy Land. I emigrated to the U.S. and now Mahtab and I are serving the Lord by starting a church.

About the Church Plant

I speak, read and write Hebrew, Farsi and English, which is unique. Our mission is to connect people to God and the church through community, reaching Muslims, Iranians and Americans and teaching these new believers to grow in their faith. "Freely you have received, freely give" (Matthew 10:8).

We believe the church glorifies God: "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God" (1 Corinthians 10:31). We believe the church is authentic: "Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.
