In 2008 we planted Discovery in Weymouth, Mass.; in 2012 Redemption Fellowship in Fall River, Mass; on January 25, 2015, Refuge Church in Warren, Rhode Island. Our fourth plant, South Coast Church, will launch in New Bedford, Mass., in September 2015.

All four plants are thriving and growing. I continue to coach each of the planters, and MeetingHouse has given people to be on each planting team.
