About the Church Plant

Church at the Beach is a uniquely designed church plant to reach the beach communities and the poor and homeless population of the urban centers. We meet outside with everything that is normally associated with an indoor church. We have a full worship band, a sermon, testimonies, baptisms, evangelism—everything except walls. We are indeed a "church without walls."

Church at the Beach also has weekly home groups, a Spanish-language Bible study, a youth group and a drama team that performs at evangelistic outreaches. We have a bread ministry that distributes food and clothing to the community. We also have regular mission trips to Mexico. More than one church plant, we represent a continued movement of churches without walls.
