### About the Church Plant

Collinsville Community Church was planted in September 2016 with a strong emphasis on spreading the gospel to Collinsville and the world in order to see the kingdom of God expanded. Our vision is to "connect everyday people to Jesus, in our community and the world." We do this by living our lives on mission and by taking the gospel to the nations.

The church is involved in the community in multiple facets so we can intentionally build relationships with people who need to hear the gospel. We currently average around 55 people on Sundays, and many of those were not involved in church prior to getting connected to CCC. Since starting community groups in October 2015 we have seen 17 people saved.
