About the Church Plant

I was recently called to be senior pastor at Butler Street, and my original church plant in Forest Park is merging with Butler Street to begin a replant initiative.

Butler Street is a 113-year-old church in the heart of downtown Atlanta that was once very active in the African American community but has fallen on hard times and entered a steep decline over the past 10 or 15 years, despite having multiple pastors. It is surrounded by a community burgeoning with millennial professionals on one end and a deep homeless population on the other. It's split almost equally between black and white ethnicities.
