About the Family

My name is Ken Witcher. I am married to an amazing wife who loves ministry as much as I do. We met in seminary in 1996 and currently have five children ages 7–16.

In the early '90s my wife, Gina, spent a year as a missionary in an inner-city youth ministry in Baltimore. Then seven years ago my family visited Baltimore with me on a business trip. We reconnected with the former youth center, now a church, and began driving up once or twice a month on weekends for almost two years. I always thought I might plant in a suburban environment somewhere, but during that time I really found a connection to the tough and broken people of this city. So in 2010, while still working as a business consultant, we began to pray about planting a church in Baltimore. Four years later I quit my job and in January of 2015 we moved to south Baltimore and immediately began to walk in our community and meet people. We met everyone who couldn't run away from us fast enough.

About the Church Plant

We launched services for Life Church Baltimore September 20 with 61 local people. Since then we have averaged around 40 attenders per week, most of whom are unchurched. Most couples are living together outside of marriage. Many have struggled with addictions and most have little to no understanding of the Bible. But these people are looking for HOPE, and they are responsive to the gospel. We have seen more than 50 decisions for Christ in the first 18 months. We're also seeing people who have not been in church for 10–20 years recommit their lives to Christ and invite their friends.

Our vision is to be a place where people can see, hear, and experience LIFE. We currently meet for worship, life groups, camps, kids and youth events.
