About the Family

My wife, Marilyn, and I moved with our youngest son, Seth, from Jacksonville, Fla., to Baltimore at the end of May 2014 for what we thought was merely a new job for my wife. But after a little more than a year, the Lord clearly showed us that He called us to Baltimore to plant a church in a neighborhood that is filled with families experiencing the same trials, trauma and troubles He had brought us through in our life.

Despite enduring all forms of abuse, neglect, abandonment, betrayal, death, miscarriages, depression and even unemployment, the grace and mercy of God have not only carried us through it all, but the Lord has blessed us with an inner river of hope and comfort to reach lost souls in our community. Our vision is to restore and create Christ-centered families and communities in Baltimore City through preaching and living out the gospel of Jesus Christ.

About the Church Plant

Our church is located in an area of East Baltimore that has seen tremendous demographic change. Once predominately Caucasian American, it is now approximately 80 percent African-American, 15 percent Latino American and 5 percent Caucasian American.

Unfortunately, the community has an average income per capita below \$25,000 per household. Only about 42 percent of adults are employed, the life expectancy is one of the lowest in the city, and it has one of the highest violence rates in the city, contributing to a significant portion of the murder rate each year. It has one of the highest teen pregnancy rates in the city, is second in the school drop-out rate, and a dismal 6 percent profess to be believers in Christ Jesus.
